

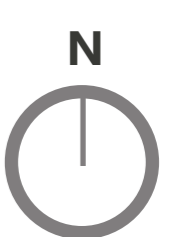

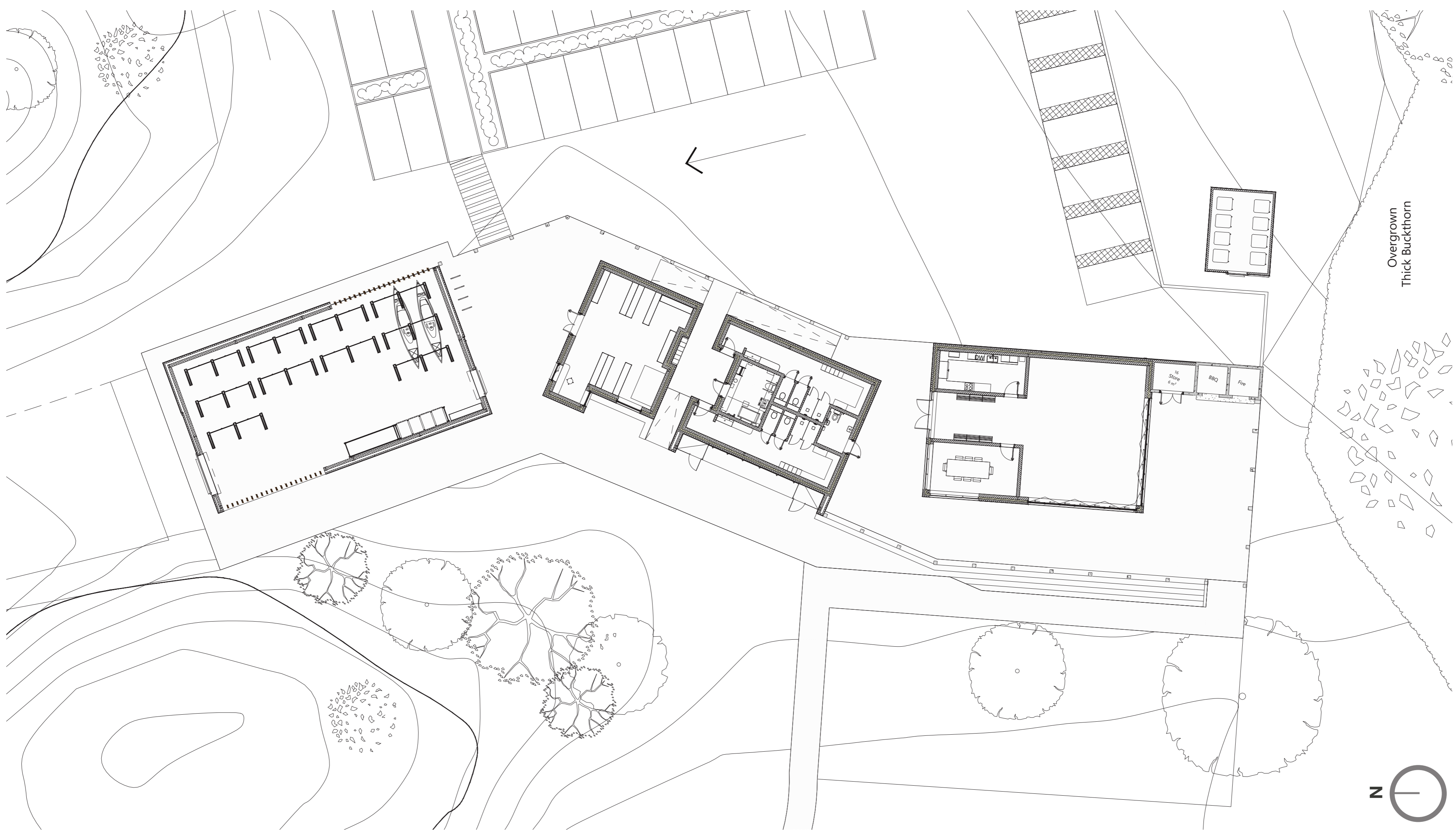
The new Camlough Recreational Hub at Camlough Lake

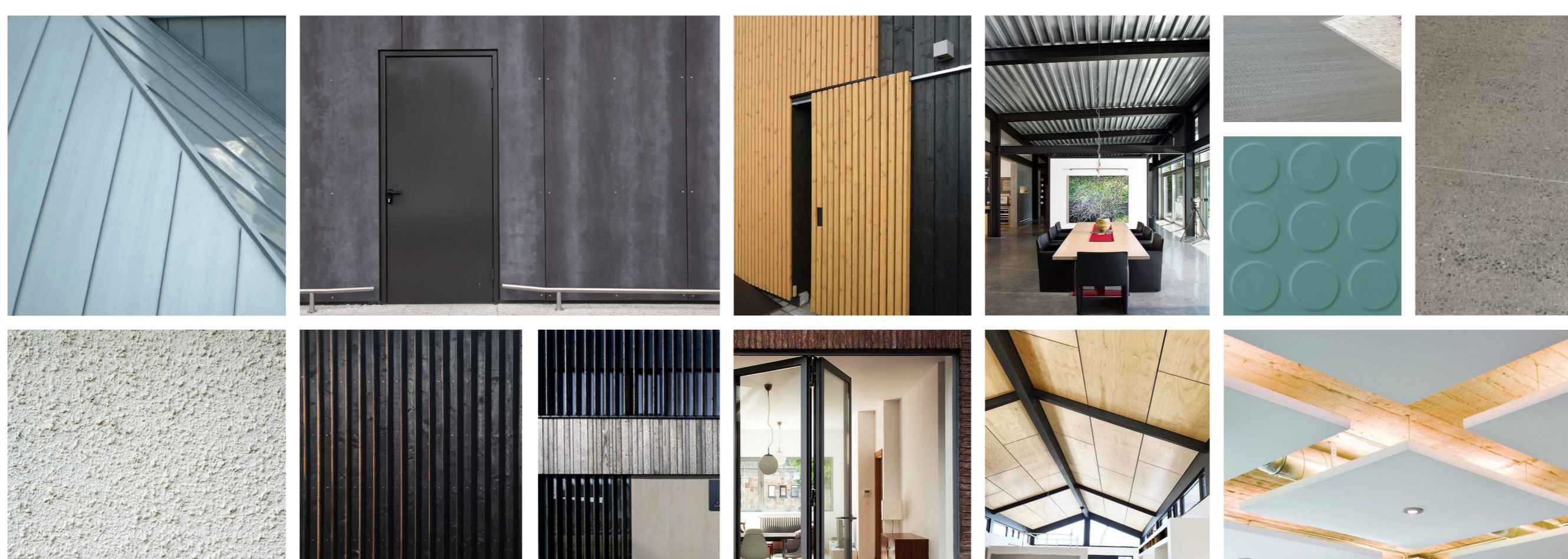

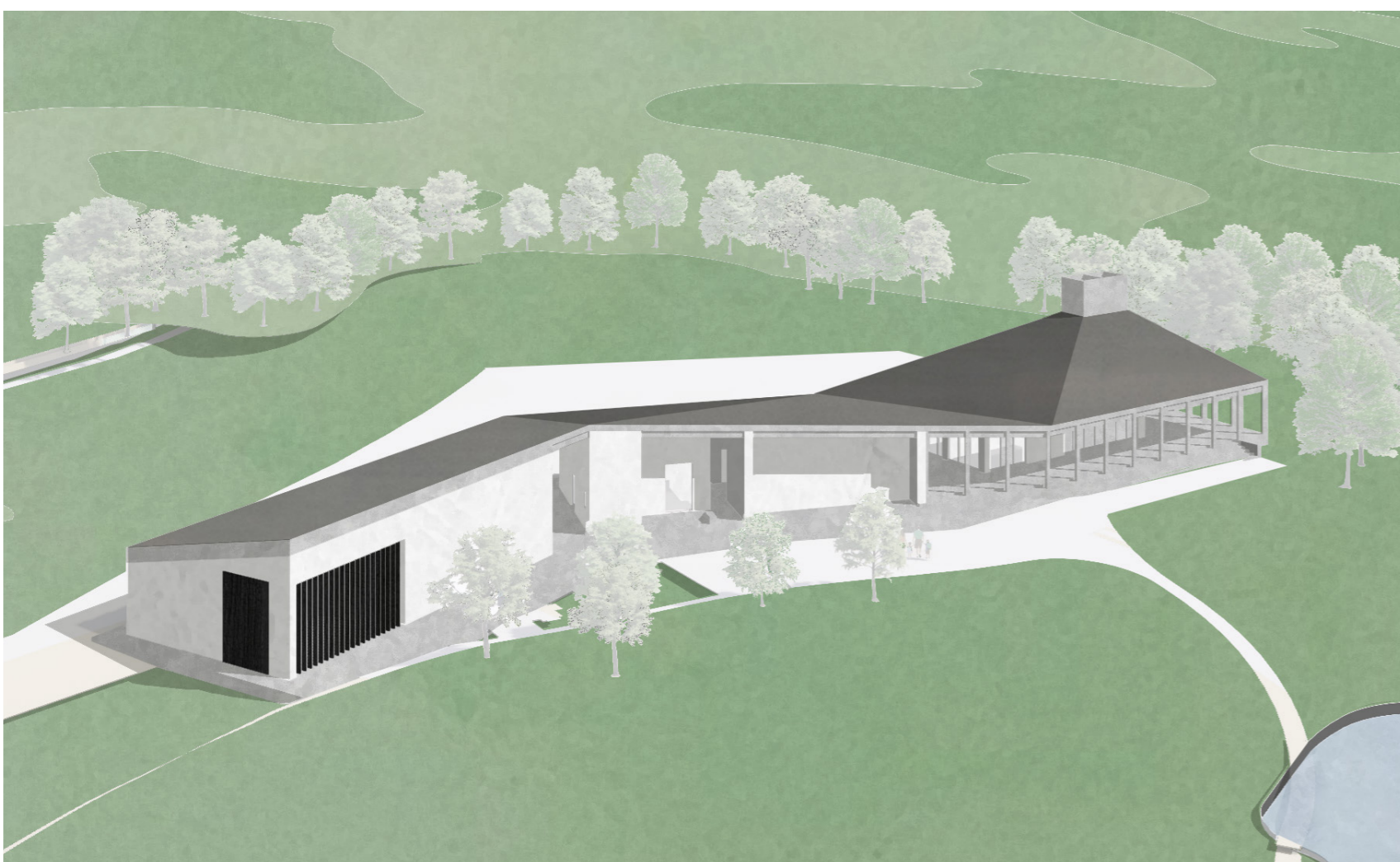
